## Easter Service at St Ethelbert's Church and End of Term

We invite our parents and school community to join us at St Ethelbert's Church on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March at 1.00 p.m. for our Easter Celebration Service.

We will return the children to school to gather their bags etc and we ask parents to collect them from the usual doors at 2.00 p.m.



## Attendance and Lateness

Governor attendance target is 96.5%

Actual attendance – 4/9/2023 –14/3/2024 - 93.4%

A reminder that children should be attending school every day on time if they are well enough to do so. If they are absent for any reason we ask that you contact the office by telephone to advise us of the reason for absence. An answerphone is available if the office is unmanned. Please do not email as these may not be checked until later in the day.

We continue to be concerned with the number of children arriving in school after our start time of 8.40 am. Gates are locked at 8.45 am, all children and parents arriving after this time must report to reception so that children can be signed into school.

Since September a total of 43 children have been late on at least one occasion. 4702 minutes of lost learning (78.37 hours, 14.24 days).

Lateness can cause distress and anxiety for the children and disrupts teachers and pupils who are already in the classroom.

We ask that you all make a big effort to arrive in school on time, ready to walk through the doors at 8.40 a.m. A chat with friends in the playground is a great way to start the day.

## Volunteers in School


We are always looking for people to volunteer to read with our children in school. If you enjoyed reading with the children yesterday and have a little time to spare each week, please get in touch.


## Chestnut Class – Science

Caterlink have issued a new summer menu which will start after the Easter break.

Also meal prices will increase with the new menu. A paid meal will be £2.71 per meal, £13.55 per week, pre-school will be £2.72 per meal, £13.60 per week.

Children in reception, year 1 and year 2 are entitled to a free universal infant school meal (UIFSM) each day.

## Free School Meals – Holiday Vouchers and Activities

We have been asked by Gloucestershire County Council to share the following information with you.

This Easter 2024 holiday period, Gloucestershire County Council will provide families in receipt of Free School Meals, who sign up to this offer, with vouchers to assist with food costs during the April (Easter) 2024 and May 2024 school holidays. Applications for holiday FSM vouchers for April 2024 and May 2024 (Easter and half term) holidays will be open from midday 27 February until midday on 12 March. We will be unable to accept any applications after this date. Vouchers for **both** holiday periods (1 week (£15) for Easter and 1 week (£15) for May half-term, a total of £30 per eligible child) will be distributed to families the week commencing 18 March 2024.

Please encourage families to check their junk/spam folders during this period as sometimes the vouchers end up there.

If parents have not received their vouchers by 20 March 2024, please encourage them to email [childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk](mailto:childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk) **before the end of the holiday period (07 April 2024)**.

The scheme is for children in reception to year 11 who receive Pupil Premium (benefits-related) free school meals and attend a school in Gloucestershire. **We are unable to consider college and sixth form students, nor children who receive infant free school meals (available to all children from reception to year 2) - they are not eligible for this scheme.**

**Families who have signed up previously do not need to re-register for Easter 2024 and May 2024 holiday vouchers-** they will already have been included. Families that have previously signed up will need to contact us with any changes to their circumstances (e.g. if the number of children eligible increases or decreases). To ensure we reach all those who are eligible, we are encouraging parents that have not previously signed up, to sign up as soon as they can.

Please note we check eligibility for the scheme by cross-referencing with the term-time free school meal register, so please make sure parents are registered beforehand. They can register by visiting the [apply for free school meals](#) page. If your school is one of the five that do not use this method, we will require confirmation from yourselves on the child's eligibility. You can find more information on what schools these are on the link above.

**Using vouchers** – vouchers need to be used will only be awarded once the parent has registered for the scheme and cannot be backdated. Vouchers are valid for 6 months, although should be used in the holiday period in which they are awarded. If vouchers are not claimed and have expired, they cannot be re-issued. Vouchers not received should be queried via email to [childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk](mailto:childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk) by the end of the holiday period.

**For any parents wishing to update details of an existing application, please ask them to email [childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk](mailto:childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk) so we can update their account, as details are not automatically updated.**
